Please note, however, <u>NO ELECTRONIC DEVICES WILL BE ACCEPTED</u> at this collection. The late summer Clean Up remains planned for 2025 where electronics will be accepted as usual. We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to a successful event.

In order to ensure compliance with DEC regulations and to facilitate work flow, we have added additional staff and we will have more dumpsters on site. Staff at the gate will verify residency and control the flow of traffic.

Please note that all materials must be sorted by metal, wood and other debris - NO HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE WILL BE ACCEPTED. If debris includes tires, there will be a \$5.00 charge per tire. Any appliance with Freon (including air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers) must be accompanied with proof of removal of the Freon by a certified technician. (For a list of certified technicians, please refer to the Yellow Pages listing under "refrigerating equipment.")

## RESTRICTED ITEMS - NO EXCEPTIONS!

## The following will not be accepted:

- Hazardous waste
- Radioactive waste
- Unapproved industrial, asbestos or medical waste
- Free liquids (i.e., paint cans with wet paint must be completely dry)
- Intact steel or plastic drums or liners (must be empty & crushed)
- Materials with less than 20% solids
- Appliances with Freon unless proof of extraction is provided
- Bulk yard waste
- Suspicious or unrecognizable materials
